Advent

I love the notion of *anticipation*. I republish this article every few years (with a few edits) at the start of the Christmas season. May we be blessed and challenged!

"Advent," is a word seldom heard in our church heritage yet it reflects a beautiful image in Scripture conveying the idea of "expectant coming." One of many such advent texts is Isaiah 7:14 – "The Lord himself will give you a sign. The virgin will be with child and give birth to a son and will call him Immanuel."

The Latin <u>adventus</u> is the translation of the Greek <u>Parousia</u> and is commonly used to refer to the Second Coming of Christ or of being "<u>present</u>." For Christians, this season recalls the coming of Christ in two ways: First: The opportunity to remember and celebrate the biblical truth of an anxiously awaited and meticulously fulfilled prophecy that would change everything as God would take on human flesh, walk among us, die for us, and rise from the grave. Second: To remind Jesus' followers to join our Lord in dispensing *peace on earth and goodwill to man*, living lives of faith and holiness as we long for our Lord's return, His second advent.

God's cosmic reclamation project began anew with the advent of Jesus in a manger. When we sinned life became death. When we turned our back on the Father, fellowship was forfeited. When we traded a relationship with Jehovah for infatuation with the world, love's essence was distorted. When we exchanged fullness in God for mere happiness on earth, joy and peace were compromised. Finally, when the time was just right the universe painfully labored like an overdue mother, the heavens pushed and then...Mary delivered! At long last as the angels sang and the stars shouted joyful relief, God's response to sin burst forth in a holy moment of a baby's birth.

The question of Christmas for us is not "Was Jesus Christ born?" We know he was! As we remember His incarnation the challenge becomes: "Will Jesus Christ be born in me? Will I walk by faith and in gratitude for the First Advent and in hope and anticipation of the Second Advent of my Lord when graves will surrender their dead and all that was lost will be restored and redeemed forever? May it be so with each of us!

"May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in Him!" Joy to the world the Lord has come!
